Mozilla Firefox


Step 1: Open Mozilla Firefox
web browser




Step 2: Open the web site you would like to set
as your homepage



Step 3: Left-click on the Hamburger Menu >
select **Options**



Step 4: General > Click Use Current Pages



Google Chrome


Step 1: Open Google Chrome web browser




Step 2: Open the web site you would like to set as your homepage



Step 3: Click on the **Customize and Control** option > **Settings**



Step 4: Under **Appearance** click the box beside **Show Home button**.
Click **Change** to type in the homepage you would like to set.



Step 5: Click on the **Home** button to take you to the homepage in Google Chrome.



Internet Explorer


Step 1: Open Internet Explorer




Step 2: In the web address bar, type in the website address of the site you would like to set as your homepage.



Step 3: Select Tools  > **Internet Options**



Step 4: Click **Use current** to set the homepage to the new site.
Click **Apply** > **OK**



Open the web site that you would like you homepage to be before opening any of the setting options.
